

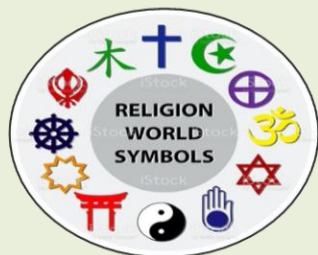
## We pray with the Church
